



## **Police Officer of the Month January 2009**

### **PFC David Dubrovich**

Chief William McMahon has selected PFC David Dubrovich as Police Officer of the Month for January 2009. In 10 days of work in January, Dubrovich made three felony and two misdemeanor arrests; responded to 49 calls for service; conducted 20 foot patrols and 50 business checks; made 32 traffic contacts; produced three insight reports; issued one criminal citation; served one summons; and served five hours in district court and four hours as a duty officer. In that time, he received three Memorandums of Recognition for his investigations on several significant incidents.

During January, Dubrovich was instrumental in several cases. He investigated an assault at a truck stop that led to the arrest of a suspect who had on his possession a shotgun, ammunition and controlled dangerous substances. The suspect was a convicted felon. In another case, Dubrovich investigated a series of burglaries at a concrete company that had caused significant production and property losses for the owner. Working with a scrap metal dealer, Dubrovich located two suspects and arrested them. He was commended by the business owner for his help in the case.

In another instance, Dubrovich provided assistance to the Maryland State Police in stopping the vehicle of a suspect involved in a hit and run. He helped stop the driver, who was determined to be under the influence. Also in January, Dubrovich investigated a malicious burning that led to a juvenile being charged and placed in a fire prevention program.

Dubrovich has proven himself to be a reliable officer who consistently turns in quality work. Congratulations to him on his selection as Police Officer of the Month for January 2009.
