To qualify, you must:

- ✓ Be 14-17 years of age
- ✓ Possess a valid Maryland Driver's license or MVA identification card
- ✓ Obtain parental consent
- ✓ Be of good moral character, verified through reference checks

This position involves youth volunteers & the Tobacco Enforcement Agent visiting tobacco vendors in Howard County and attempting to purchase cigarettes. If the vendor sells, the clerk and vendor are cited by the Health Department for selling to minors. If no sale is



made, the vendor is commended. This continues until all vendors have been visited. Safety of the youth volunteers is of the utmost importance and our first priority. We

cannot do our jobs without your help. So, sign up for this exciting opportunity to earn community service hours and help stomp out underage smoking. Hours are very flexible.
