CRASH SENDS THREE TO SHOCK TRAUMA

The Traffic Enforcement Section is investigating a serious motor vehicle collision that sent three Howard County residents to the University of Maryland – Shock Trauma. The head-on collision occurred on Guilford Road west of Murray Hill Road at approx. 9:10 PM on Wednesday, August 6, 2003.

A 1993 Acura Integra being operated by Michael Davis, 17 years of age, was traveling at a high rate of speed westbound on Guilford Road when he failed to negotiate a slight curve at Murray Hill Road. The Acura skidded across the double yellow line and struck a Subaru Forrester, knocking the Subaru onto the sidewalk.

Mr. Davis and his passenger, Alexander Camorali were flown to Shock Trauma by MSP Medivac Helicopter. Mr. Davis resides in the 970 blk. Early Spring Way Columbia Maryland and is listed in critical condition at Shock Trauma. Mr. Camarali, 18 years of age, resides in the 5400 blk. Halfflight Garth Columbia Maryland and is listed in stable condition.

The operator of the Subaru is identified as Christine Marie Duce 28 years of age is from the 8800 blk. of Willowood Way Columbia Maryland. She is listed in stable condition at Shock Trauma.

The preliminary investigation reveals that speed is a factor in the collision, which is still under investigation by Officer Justice.
