EXCESSIVE SPEED SENDS ONE TO SHOCK TRAUMA

The Howard County Traffic Enforcement Section is investigating a single vehicle collision that sent the driver to the University of Maryland – Shock Trauma. The collision occurred on the ramp of northbound U.S. 29 to westbound Brokenland Parkway on Monday, August 24, at approximately 9:18 a.m..

Alexander Logan Bryan, 24, was driving a 2007 Toyota Yaris on the ramp at a high speed when he traveled off the right side roadway and struck a tree. After striking the tree, the Toyota rolled onto its side and into a ditch.

Bryan was transported to Shock Trauma by the Maryland State Police MedEvac and is listed in critical condition. Bryan resides on Ridings Way in Laurel.

Charges are pending further investigation by PFC N. Bingham.
