**Three-vehicle collision on Md. 32
kills Sykesville man**

The Howard County Police traffic enforcement section is investigating a fatal collision that occurred on Sept. 10 at approximately 5:23 p.m. The three-vehicle collision occurred when the driver of an Acura 3.5 was stopped on northbound Md. 32 to make a left turn onto Amberwoods Way. The Acura was struck in the rear by a northbound Chevrolet Express van, and the Acura was pushed across the double yellow line, where it was stuck by a southbound Dodge pick-up truck.

The driver of the Acura, Brian Edgar Emery, 49, of the 12000 block of Forest Creek Court in Sykesville, was pronounced dead on the scene. The operator of the at-fault Chevrolet van is identified as Thomas Donald Cory, 55, of the 1500 block of Henryton Road in Marriottsville. Cory was not injured.

The operator of the Dodge pick-up truck is identified as Robert Lewis Wyscarver, 40, of the 9300 block of Millbrook Road in Ellicott City. He was transported to Howard County General Hospital with minor injuries.

Charges are pending further investigation by PFC Krieger.
