## **Man Robs Subway, Tries to Rob Bank in Same Week** *Police Release Photos, Offer Reward in Hopes of Identification*

The Howard County Police Department is investigating the robbery of a food chain and an attempted robbery of a bank, and is asking for the public's help in locating the man they believe to be responsible for both incidents. Police are offering a \$1,000 reward and releasing photos of the suspect in hopes that he will be identified.

The first incident occurred on Tuesday, Sept. 11 at 11:30 a.m. at the Subway restaurant in Elkridge on Route 1 near Montgomery Road. The suspect entered the store, demanded cash, and fled with an undisclosed amount of money.

The second incident occurred on Friday, Sept. 14 at 1:00 p.m. at the BB&T Bank at Route 1 and Montgomery Road. The suspect entered the bank, approached a teller and demanded money. Other employees contacted police and the suspect eventually left without obtaining any money.

The suspect did not display or imply a weapon in either case. He is described as a white male, 5'9"- 6' in height, average to thin build, in his 40's, with short dark hair, pock marks on his face and wearing prescription glasses.
