## **14-year-old hospitalized after cycling collision**

The Howard County police traffic enforcement section is investigating a personal injury collision involving a 14-year-old boy on his bicycle and a passenger vehicle.

The collision occurred on Twin Rivers Road in Columbia on Monday at approximately 5:57 p.m. The operator of a Ford Focus was traveling westbound on Twin Rivers Road approaching two bicyclists traveling along the right side of the roadway. As the operator of the Ford was passing the cyclists, one of them made an abrupt left turn directly in front of the Ford and was struck by the vehicle.

Sergial Brown, 14, of the 10000 block of Nightmist Court in Columbia, was flown by Maryland State Police MedEvac to Johns Hopkins Hospital, where he is listed in stable condition.

The operator of the Ford Focus is identified as Sandra Leland, 61, of the 5600 block of Harpers Farm Road in Columbia. Leland was not injured in the collision.

The investigation is continuing by PFC Adams. At this time, charges against Leland are not anticipated.
