Van Cuts Off Jeep, Results in Driver's Death; Police Asking for Public's Help

A man died this Saturday after his vehicle was cut off by a white full sized van, causing the victim to travel into the median of Route 29 and overturn. The suspect failed to stop, and police are asking for the public's help in locating the person responsible.

The collision occurred at approximately 6:12 p.m. on Route 29 just prior to Route 40. A northbound white van changed lanes in front of a Jeep Wrangler, which swerved into the median to avoid the van. The Jeep overturned and came to rest on the ramp that leads from Rt. 40 to southbound Rt. 29.

The operator of the Jeep has been identified as *Matthew Augustine Miller*, 23 years of age, of the 8300 blk. Woodland Road in Millersville. Mr. Miller was pronounced dead on the scene.

Police are seeking information on the suspect vehicle and driver. Any person who witnessed the incident or has information is asked to contact the Police Department at 410-313-3700.
