Police Identify Suspects Wanted in Armed Robberies, Shooting *\$5,000 Reward Offered for Information Leading to Arrest*

Howard County Police have identified the two men wanted in a series of three armed robberies, one which resulted in the shooting of a gas station clerk. Terrence Edward Boone, 24, and Shawn Timothy Crockett, 14, both of Baltimore City, were identified through evidence found at the scene of one of the robberies and have been charged with the crimes. Police are offering a \$5,000 reward to anyone with information leading to their capture.

Boone and Crockett have been charged with the Oct. 5 armed robbery of the 2-Go store in the 9000 block of Washington Blvd., the Oct. 11 armed robbery of the Harwood Convenience store in the 6600 blk. of Washington Blvd., and the Oct. 16 shooting of a clerk at the Exxon station in the 10100 blk. of Little Patuxent Parkway.

Crockett has been charged as an adult. Both subjects face multiple charges, including first and second degree attempted murder, first and second degree assault, armed robbery, and handgun violations.
