Police investigating homicide at Halloween party *Reward of up to \$5,000 offered for information*

Howard County police are investigating a homicide that occurred during a Halloween party in Clarksville overnight. Police received multiple calls from partygoers at a home in the 11500 block of Manorstone Lane around 1:15 a.m. indicating that shots had been fired inside the residence.

Investigators are reporting that one victim is deceased at the scene, one was transported to Shock Trauma in critical condition and two were taken to Howard County General Hospital with non-life-threatening injuries. The victims are all male. Victim information, including names and ages, will be released after family members have been notified.

Police responded to the scene and found more than 100 people at the residence. Detectives are talking with people at the scene and do not yet have suspect information available for release.

Investigators will release additional information as it becomes available.

Police are offering a reward of up to \$5,000 for information and are urging anyone with information to call 410-313-3200.
