PASSENGER EJECTED IN WEEKEND CRASH DIES; DRIVER CHARGED WITH MANSLAUGHTER

The Traffic Enforcement Section is investigating a single vehicle collision where an unbelted passenger was ejected and killed. The single vehicle collision occurred on Saturday, Nov. 8 at approximately 2:24 a.m. on Harpers Farm Road at Twin Rivers Road.

A Ford Ranger pickup truck was traveling southbound on Harpers Farm Road when the operator lost control, went into the median and stuck a tree. The vehicle overturned and the unbelted front seat passenger was ejected. The subject was transported by ambulance to the University of Maryland – Shock Trauma, where he died over the weekend. He has been identified as Roger Gene Bartrug, 2nd, 22, of the 6100blk. Turnabout Lane Columbia Maryland.

The driver fled from the scene, but was arrested at his residence several hours later. He has been identified as Alexander Randolph Camorali, 23, of the 5400 blk. of Half Flight Garth, Columbia. Mr. Camorali has been charged with driving on a suspended license, hit and run, and vehicular manslaughter.
