Suspect Shot, Killed After Robbing Bank, Fleeing Police

Two men are still outstanding and another has been shot by police after they committed a bank robbery in Clarksville, fled in their vehicle, and then ran from and shot at police.

The incident began around 9:15 a.m., when the Howard County 9-1-1 center received a call and then a hold-up alarm from the Bank of America, located in the 6300 block of Ten Oaks Rd. in Clarksville, Howard County. Three armed men entered the bank and announced a robbery. At some point during the incident, a suspect shot a bank employee in the hand. The suspects then fled in a pick-up truck.

A citizen followed the suspect's vehicle and provided their location to the police. Once police located the vehicle, they attempted to stop it, but the suspect vehicle fled. Howard County Police pursued the vehicle with assistance from other jurisdictions through Anne Arundel, Prince George's and Montgomery counties. The suspects bailed-out of the vehicle near Angelton Court and Greencastle Road in Montgomery County.

Police from multiple jurisdictions pursued the suspects on foot. One suspect fired at police, who returned fire. That suspect was shot and was transported to the hospital, where he died.

The two additional suspects are still outstanding. Police are still on scene attempting to locate them.
