## **Police Offer Reward up to \$5,000 for Information Leading to Third Bank Robbery Suspect**

Police are offering up to \$5,000 for information leading to the arrest and indictment of the third suspect involved in a bank robbery that ended in a police-involved shooting yesterday.

Yesterday morning around 9:15, three armed suspects entered the Bank of America in the 6300 block of Ten Oaks Rd. in Clarksville. After shooting an employee in the hand, the suspects fled with cash. Police pursued the suspects in a multi-jurisdictional chase that ended in a bail-out in Burtonsville.

One suspect was shot and killed by officers after he fired upon them. Another was taken into custody last night by Montgomery County police and turned over to the FBI. The money taken during the robbery was recovered at the shooting scene. Police are not releasing the amount of money taken.

The third suspect who is still at-large is described as a light-skinned black male who was wearing all dark clothing at the time of the robbery. Police do not have photos available to release at this time.

Police are working jointly with the FBI in this investigation. Callers with information about the identity or location of the third suspect may remain anonymous and should contact police at 410-313-3200.

The reward is being offered by the Howard County Police Department and the Maryland Association for Bank Security.
