Man Poses as Armored Car Driver, Steals Money from Bank *Police Searching for Suspect, Reward up to \$10,000*

Howard County police are searching for a man who posed as an armored car driver today and made off with a large amount of cash. The man walked into the Bank of America in the 9100 block of Baltimore National Pike in Ellicott City dressed as a security employee and left with bags of money.

After the suspect picked up the cash, he drove off in what appeared to be a personal car. Bank employees became suspicious and contacted the security company, which confirmed that the pick-up was unauthorized.
