Suspect Robs Ellicott City Bank *Police Release Photos, Offer \$1,000 Reward*

The Howard County Police Department is announcing a \$1,000 reward for information about a suspect who robbed an Ellicott City bank yesterday. Police are releasing photos today and asking for the public's help in identifying and locating the suspect.

The man entered the Provident Bank inside the Wal-Mart store in the 3200 block of Ridge Rd. around 12:48 p.m. He walked to a teller and quietly demanded cash. The suspect took an undisclosed amount of money and fled the bank. No one was injured in the incident.

The suspect is described as a black male in his mid-30s, approximately 5'10" to 6' tall, weighing around 180 lbs.

At the time of the robbery, the suspect had a small amount of facial hair and was wearing a beige baseball hat and a long-sleeved beige shirt.

Police are asking anyone with information to call 410-313-3200. Callers can remain anonymous if requested.
