Howard Police Release a Photo of Attempted Bank Robbery Suspect

The Howard County Police Department is seeking information on a suspect who attempted to rob the Columbia Bank October 16. Police are releasing a photo of the suspect and offering a reward up to \$1,000 to anyone with information leading to an arrest.

The incident occurred in the 10400 block of Twin Rivers Road when a lone male entered the Columbia Bank around 3:05 p.m. in an attempt to commit a robbery. The suspect implied he had a weapon, but no cash was given. Suspect fled in an unknown direction.

The suspect is described as black male, 30-40 years of age, approximately 5' 10" and 160 lbs., wearing blue jeans, a blue jacket, a red baseball hat and glasses.
