Howard Police Release Photos of Bank Robbery Suspect

The Howard County Police Department is seeking information on two suspects who robbed a Provident Bank in Columbia Oct. 22. Police are releasing photos of the suspects and offering a reward up to \$1,000 for anyone with information leading to an arrest.

The incident occurred in the 9000 block of Snowden River Parkway when two males entered the bank around 1:40 p.m. to commit a robbery. The suspects displayed handguns and were given cash. The suspects left in an unknown direction. No one was injured.

The suspects are described as:

Suspect #1: Black male, approximately 6'0", 25-35 years of age, wearing a dark colored hooded sweatshirt.

Suspect #2: Black male, approximately 5'9", 25-35 years of age, medium build, wearing brown long sleeve shirt, greenish colored pants and a white and blue knit hat.

Police are asking anyone with information on the robbery to contact the Howard County Police Department at 410-313-3200. Callers can remain anonymous.
