Police Release Photo of Suspect Wanted for Burglary

Howard County Police are asking for the public's help in locating the man wanted in connection with a series of burglaries. Charles Petty Smith Jr., 49, (03/20/1955) is wanted on numerous counts of burglary, and theft in Howard and Baltimore Counties. Police investigators identified Smith after he pawned several stolen items taken in the burglaries.

On Sept 24 in the 10700 block of Hunting Drive, Columbia, Smith forced entry into a home and took audio/video equipment, coins and jewelry.

On Sept 28 in the 3900 block of Spring Meadow Drive, Ellicott City, Smith forced entry into a home and took tools.

On Oct 4 in the 4000 block of High Point Road, Ellicott City, Smith entered a home and took camera equipment, a camcorder, television and a generator.

On Oct 6 in the 8600 block of Wheatfield Way, Ellicott City, Smith forced entry into a home took two televisions, and jewelry.

Police have released a photograph of Smith today and describe him as a black male, 5 feet 11 inches tall, weighing about 210 lbs. Anyone with information on Smith's whereabouts is urged to call police immediately at 410-313-2200.
