The Traffic Enforcement Section is investigating a serious motor vehicle collision that occurred on Tuesday, Sept. 12 at approximately 3:00 p.m. The two-vehicle collision occurred on US Rt. 29 just south of the Rivers Edge Road intersection when a northbound Toyota Camry crossed the median and began traveling north in the southbound lane. After entering the southbound lanes, the Camry traveled for approximately 200 feet and struck a southbound Chevrolet Cavalier.

The Toyota Camry contained the driver plus three passengers. The right front passenger was taken to the University of Maryland – Shock Trauma with non- life threatening injuries. The driver of this vehicle and the passenger were taken to local hospitals with minor injuries.

The driver of the Chevrolet Cavalier was transported to the University of Maryland- Shock Trauma and is in serious condition.

The names of the drivers and passengers are being held pending further verification.

Charges against the driver of the Toyota Camry are pending further investigation by Pfc. Joseph. Gallina.
