Driver Struck by Dump Truck Dies

The 62-year old woman who was struck by a dump truck yesterday afternoon on Route 32 died this morning from her injuries.

Around 12:09 p.m. yesterday, Elizabeth Ann Marsh was driving northbound on Route 32 in a Chevrolet Prism when she attempted to turn left at the exit ramp from Route 70, where left hand turns are prohibited. A 2005 Kenilworth dump truck traveling southbound struck Marsh as she pulled into the southbound lanes to attempt the turn.

Marsh was transported to Shock Trauma in critical condition and died this morning.

The driver of the dump truck has been identified as Michael Brian Hill, 31, of Columbia. He was not injured. The dump truck is owned by TCB Transport of Laurel.

The investigation is continuing by PFC Tanhauser.
