Police Release Photos of Persons of Interest in Armed Robbery Case *\$10,000 Reward Offered*

The Howard County Police Department released photos today of two persons of interest in an investigation into a recent armed robbery at a Giant Food Store in Columbia. Giant is offering a \$10,000 reward for information that leads to the arrest and conviction of a suspect in this case.

On Oct. 26, the Giant Store in the Wilde Lake Village Center was robbed by a man displaying a handgun. The suspect stole cash and fled. No one was injured.

Yesterday, two subjects of interest were seen at the Giant Food Store in the Dorsey Search Village Center in Ellicott City. Police would like to identify and talk with the men.

The first subject is a black male with a goatee and heavy build. He is wearing a blue baseball cap with a red bill, white trim and unknown writing. He also is wearing a black cloth jacket with leather trim on the shoulders. The second subject is a black male with a moustache and is approximately six feet tall. He is wearing a green camouflage jacket with a green knit cap.
