Police Apprehend Robbery Suspects

Howard County Police arrested two subjects after receiving a report of a robbery in the 9400 block of Baltimore National Pike in Ellicott City on August 31.

At approximately 10:26p.m. police received a report of an armed robbery at Domino's Pizza. Victim manager reported that a black male suspect approached the business carrying a duffle bag. The suspect then produced a small black handgun and pointed it at the manager. The suspect then ordered the victim to open the cash register and the safe. The suspect took the cash register drawer and the cash from the safe and placed it in the duffle bag and fled in a white older box style vehicle.

A patrol officer observed the suspect vehicle traveling east on Baltimore National Pike near Rogers Avenue. The officer called for police assistance and attempted to make a traffic stop. The driver of the vehicle refused to stop and continued into Baltimore County. Baltimore County and Baltimore City police officers responded to offer assistance.

The pursuit traveled through Baltimore County into Baltimore and ended near Denison and Edmondson Avenue where the suspect vehicle drifted into a parked car causing minor damage. Two suspects fled from the vehicle and were apprehended a short time later.

The cash register drawer was recovered at the scene and U.S. currency was recovered from the suspects and vehicle.

There were no injuries reported during this incident.
