ARMED COMMERCIAL ROBBERY

The Howard County Police Department is investigating an armed commercial robbery occurring on Monday, August 30, 2004 at approximately 9:30 P.M., at the High's Convenience Store, located at 12780 Route 144, in West Friendship. A lone suspect entered the unoccupied store and approached the store clerk, (Identified as a 25 yoa male from Sykesville) and placed a white colored bandanna over his facial region. The suspect then displayed and pointed a dark colored revolver at the victim, and demanded U.S. Currency. The suspect fled out of the store on foot with an unknown amount of currency. The clerk was not injured as the result of this robbery. Anyone with information pertaining to this crime should contact the Howard County Police Department via (410)313-3200. SUSPECT: Unknown white male, twenties, 6' 1" 150 lbs., shaved head with short stubble, unshaven facial region, white bandanna, white mesh shirt, blue jeans, armed with a dark colored revolver.
