### **Multi-Jurisdictional Investigation Leads to Four Arrests**

*Suspects Charged in Connection with Several Howard and Baltimore County  
Game Store Robberies*

Three male suspects and one female suspect have been arrested and charged with several game store armed robberies that took place over the past few months in Howard and Baltimore Counties. William Singleton, 38, of Woodlawn, Jennifer Denise Vaughn, 21, of Baltimore, Richard Lane Harris, 31, of Baltimore, and Frankie Leon Mark, 42, of Baltimore have each been charged with counts of armed robbery, assault, theft and other related offenses. Additionally, Mark faces charges of possession of a firearm after having been convicted of a felony.

The first Howard County robbery that the suspects have been charged with took place on Sept. 22, when the suspects entered the EB Games store on Dobbin Center Way in Columbia. The suspects displayed a knife and fled with video games and game systems. Singleton, Vaughn and Harris have been charged in connection with this incident.

The second Howard County robbery, which involved the use of a handgun, took place on Oct. 13 at the Gamestop on Route 40 in Ellicott City. Vaughn, Harris and Mark have been charged in connection with that robbery.

The four suspects have also been charged by Baltimore County Police in connection with two game store robberies in their area.
