Suspect Stabs Two Women, Is Apprehended by Police

Howard County Police have arrested and charged a man with attempted murder and first degree assault after he stabbed two women in a hotel in Jessup and then fled the scene.

Police were called to the Red Roof Inn in the 8000 block of Washington Blvd. at 4 a.m. for a report of a woman stabbed. Upon arrival police located the victim, a 20-year-old female, who had sustained several stab wounds. She was flown to Shock Trauma in serious condition. She has been identified as Kayla Lauren Miller of Severn.

Police located the suspect a short distance from the hotel after receiving information from witnesses. He was identified as 23-year-old Robert Charles Logan of West Friendship, and arrested.

Through interviews with the victim, police learned that a second victim had been stabbed during the incident, but had fled prior to police arrival. The second victim was later located at another area hotel suffering from stab wounds and was transported to Shock Trauma. She has been identified as 44-year-old Joni Lynn O'Conner of Jessup.

Injuries to both women are non-life threatening. Police are continuing to investigate.
