## **Police Investigating Suspicious Death**

Howard County Police are investigating the suspicious death of a 44-year-old Chestertown, Md., man discovered in Jessup last night. The body of Eugene Paul McAllister, of the 400 block of Peartree Point Road, was found in his vehicle by police around 7:30 p.m. The cause of McAllister's death was not evident and police are unsure how long ago he died.

On Dec. 19, the Queen Anne's County Sheriff's Office received a report that McAllister had been missing since the previous day. He was last seen dropping off a family member at the Baltimore-Washington International airport Dec. 18. Queen Anne's County detectives began investigating the missing person case and were lead to the Washington Blvd. area of Jessup last night.

Queen Anne's detectives contacted Howard County Police to assist in the investigation. McAllister's Toyota Corolla was discovered at the Greenway Motel in the 7700 block of Washington Blvd. McAllister did not have identification on his person and was identified through photographs.

Investigators are awaiting autopsy results and are unsure when they will be available. Police will release additional information as it becomes available.
