TRAFFIC ENFORCEMENT SECTION

The Traffic Enforcement Section of the Howard County Police Department is investigating a personal injury motor vehicle collision involving four vehicles that occurred on, Saturday, November 6, 2004 at 1554 hours eastbound MD Rt 175 and MD Rt 108, Jessup, Howard County.

The preliminary investigation revealed that a 2001 Chrysler LHS was traveling eastbound on MD Rt 175 approaching MD Rt 108. The Chrysler moved from lane 2 to lane 3 in front of a 2001 Tractor Trailer that was traveling eastbound in lane 3. The Tractor Trailer applied its brakes and attempted to move to the right and was positioned between lanes 3 and 4. The Tractor Trailer then struck the rear of a 1987 Oldsmobile which was stopped in traffic in lane 4 eastbound MD Rt 175 at the intersection. The Tractor Trailer then struck the Chrysler in the rear and pushed it into the intersection. As the Tractor Trailer continued to travel it sideswiped a 1999 Plymouth Breeze which was stopped in traffic in front of the Oldsmobile.

The driver of the Plymouth was identified as Henry Brown, 44 yoa, of the 400 block of Olympic Court, Fort Washington, MD. Mr Brown was not injured in the collision.

The driver and passenger of the Oldsmobile were identified as James Delong, 39 yoa, of the 6000 block of Majors Lane, Columbia, MD, and his 6 year old son. Both Mr Delong and his son were transported to Howard County General Hospital and are listed in stable condition.

The driver of the Tractor Trailer was identified as Martin Hall, 22 yoa, of the 200 block of Oak Street, Rensselaer, IN. Mr Hall was transported to Howard County General Hospital and is listed in stable condition.

The driver and passenger of the Chrysler were identified as Peter Beyak, 48 yoa, and Judy Beyak, 50 yoa, of the 6700 block of Hunter Road, Elkridge, MD. Both Mr and Mrs Beyak were transported to the University of Maryland Shock Trauma and are listed in stable condition.

The collision is still under investigation by Pfc Joseph Gallina of the Traffic Enforcement Section.
