Howard County Shooting Victim Dies

Howard County Police have confirmed that the victim shot in a robbery today has died as a result of his injuries. Jun Kim Kwang, 53, of the 3000 block of Lancelot Cross in Ellicott City, was shot outside of the Jessup Deli in Jessup at around 11:30 a.m. Kwang, who was the owner of the business, was carrying two bank bags of cash at the time of the incident. Two suspects were apprehended shortly after the shooting by Baltimore County police officers.

A Howard County police officer spotted the suspect's vehicle, described to officers by a witness, minutes after the shooting traveling eastbound on Rt. 40. The officer called for police assistance and attempted to make a traffic stop. The driver of the vehicle refused to stop and continued into Baltimore County. Baltimore County police officers responded to offer assistance.

The pursuit traveled through Baltimore County into Baltimore and ended near S. Athol Avenue when the suspect's vehicle struck a stone pillar. Baltimore County Police initiated the apprehension of two suspects inside the car. The release of additional information about the apprehension is being handled by Baltimore Police.
