**Executive Order: 2015 -05  
Date: May 26, 2015  
Subject: Establishing an Adequate  
Public Facilities Review  
Task Force**

**WHEREAS**, the 1990 General Plan called for the enactment of legislation requiring adequate public facilities as a condition of subdivision or land development approval; and

**WHEREAS**, on or about February 3, 1992, the County Council passed Council Bill No. 7-1992 that adopted the Adequate Public Facilities Act of Howard County (the "Act"); and

**WHEREAS**, the Act was effective on April 10, 1992; and

**WHEREAS**, there have been numerous amendments to the Act since it was enacted; and

**WHEREAS**, the Act is now almost 25 years old and is in need of review to see if it remains a productive tool for the County or if further amendments are needed; and

**WHEREAS**, the County Executive wishes to form an Adequate Public Facilities Review Task Force to review the Act and make recommendations on improvements to the Act.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDERED** that an Adequate Public Facilities Review Task Force is hereby established and shall issue a report based on the following mission:

1. To review the Act and make recommendations as to possible improvements.
2. To review the Act's allocations test, school test, and roads test methodology and make recommendations as to possible improvements.
3. To review the Maryland Department of Planning's Models and Guidelines reports, Adequate Public Facilities Ordinances, to determine other public facilities that have been included in other Maryland jurisdictions and may be appropriate to consider in Howard County.

**AND BE IT FURTHER ORDERED**, that the Task Force will consist of the following members:
