Kittleman announces new date for town hall on Ellicott City flood rebuilding efforts

ELLICOTT CITY, MD – Howard County Executive Allan H. Kittleman today announced that the Ellicott City Recovery Town Hall meeting has been rescheduled for Wednesday, Sept. 14 from 7:00 p.m. to 8:30 p.m. at Veterans Elementary School, 4355 Montgomery Road in Ellicott City. The Town Hall was previously scheduled for Thursday, September 15 and was moved to resolve a scheduling conflict.

Kittleman will provide updates on recovery efforts as well as field questions from residents, businesses and property owners. Jim Robey, senior advisor for Community Recovery and Chairman of the Historic Ellicott City Recovery Community Advisory Group, will attend, as will Council Vice Chairman Jon Weinstein, who represents Ellicott City and was appointed by Kittleman to chair the #ECStrong Recovery Fund Committee.

“We need to continue to keep the lines of communication open with those impacted by the flood,” said Kittleman. “We are committed to rebuilding an even better Ellicott City but we want to make sure that the process is collaborative and that we include as many individuals as possible.”
