Howard County establishes location for information to help those affected by flooding on Main Street

ELLICOTT CITY, MD – Howard County has established a single location where residents, business owners and property owners impacted by Saturday's severe flooding on Main Street in Ellicott City can get information about agencies and organizations that will be offering assistance with recovery efforts.

"It's important for those impacted by the flooding to have a one-stop shop to get the assistance they need," Howard County Executive Allan H. Kittleman said. "These people have already experienced tremendous loss. We need to help them navigate the system efficiently."

Representatives from Howard County Government, State government and nonprofit organizations will be on hand to answer questions and to assist individuals with accessing needed services.
