Compare State and Local Capacities

Reasons for differences include:

1. Difference in capacity calculation formula:

ES Local: (22 per K room) + (19 per GrV1-2 room) + (25 per Gr 3-5 room)

ES State: (22 per K room) + (23 per Gr 1-5 room) + (20 per **PreK** room) + (10 per **Special Ed** room)

MS Local: 20.5(class size) x 95%(usage) x number of classrooms

MS State: (25(class size) x 85%(usage) x number of classrooms) + (10 per **Special Ed** room)

HS Local: 25(class size) x 80% or 85%(usage) x number of classrooms

HS State: (25(class size) x 85%(usage) x number of classrooms) + (10 per **Special Ed** room)

2. The local capacity **excludes** Prek and Special Education classrooms in the calculation.

3. The state calculates the SRC based on a room use at a specific time and revisits the calculation after a capital project or at the LEA's request. The local capacities are assessed and calculated with level-wide capacity studies based on the room use and the purpose of the room and as needed with capital projects.

4. The state requires minimum square footage of ES 550SF and MS/HS 500SF and students must occupy the classroom 60% of the school day to include the classroom in the count.
