



Main Street Plan -- September 17 Thru October 6

Access

Vehicle traffic:

- The Patapsco River Bridge will reopen to two-way traffic on Saturday September 17 at 7:00 a.m. for access to Maryland Avenue and St. Paul Street. Commuters are requested to seek alternate routes.
- Beginning on Saturday, September 17, at 7:00 a.m., Main Street will reopen to two-way vehicle traffic from Forrest Street to Old Columbia Pike. This will allow vehicles to come down Main Street and turn right onto Old Columbia Pike. Likewise, traffic coming down Old Columbia Pike will be allowed to turn left onto Main Street.

Main Street access between Old Columbia Pike and Maryland Avenue beginning Saturday, September 17 at 7:00 a.m.

For residents, businesses and property owners:

- Main Street between Old Columbia Pike and Maryland Avenue will open to ALL **CREDENTIALLED** individuals for **FULL, 24/7, UNLIMITED ACCESS**. This includes residents, businesses, property owners, and construction workers authorized to be working in the zone either as employees/contractors of Howard County, BGE, or business/property owners.
- Credential entrance checkpoints will be just east of Old Columbia Pike and just west of Maryland Avenue.
- If your building has been inspected, approved and deemed safe for occupancy, you will be allowed to move back in. Tenants should check with landlords before reoccupying. The County will contact property owners if their buildings have been deemed unsafe.
- All previous credentials are still valid. Wristbands are required for family, friends, clients, customers and contractors. Those wristbands are available for pick-up to be distributed by the credentialed individuals themselves. Credentialing will be available thru October 6:

Vehicles

For residents: Personal vehicles will be allowed on Main Street for loading and unloading **ONLY**. (See parking section for additional details.)

For businesses, property owners, contractors: Within the restricted area, only vehicles needed by contractors and owners for work being done on a property will be allowed to park on Main Street. Those vehicles may be asked to move to allow BGE and the Department of Public Works access should they need to work in that space.

Traffic flow

All credentialed and approved vehicle traffic on Main Street will be one-way, eastbound, between Old Columbia Pike and Maryland Avenue.

Parking

- On-street parking of personal vehicles will be prohibited on ALL of Main Street. Parking will be available in the following lots:
 - Lot A
 - Lot C
 - Lot D (A small portion of Lot D remains a construction staging area. Until further notice, two-way access to Lot D will be from Old Columbia Pike onto Roussey Lane. There will be no direct access to or from Main Street.)
 - Lot E
 - Lot F
- On the portion of Main Street between Ellicott Mills Drive and Old Columbia Pike, only construction/contractor vehicles will be allowed to park in order to assist with rebuilding. No overnight parking will be allowed.
