Howard County residents are eligible to receive a free 55-gal barrel (with cut-outs for fittings) to be used as a rain barrel (*one barrel per address, please*) compliments of the County. Proof of county residence is required. Resident must buy fittings, assemble and install the rain barrel. Rain barrel must be used in Howard County.

Recipient of barrel must fill out pledge form and attend a workshop at the Gazebo, located on the right, just past the main entrance to the landfill (*dates above*). Details about where to buy fittings and how to assemble, use and maintain the rain barrel will be discussed

Workshops (see above for 11 dates this season) are ongoing from **9:00 am to 11:00 am**. Advance registration is not required.
