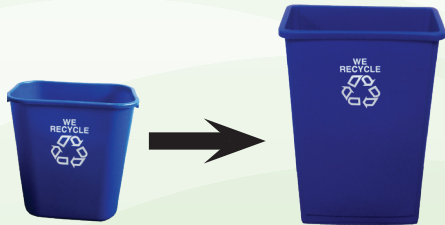




How Do I Recycle?

Why Recycle?

- Make sure recyclables are clean, empty and dry.
- Flatten all cardboard boxes.
