Note: Section 16.1104(d) of the Adequate Public Facilities Ordinance allows the Department of Planning and Zoning to grant 20% more Tentative Allocations than the Adopted Total for each region for the current allocation year.

Note: For Growth & Revitalization allocations, no more than 1,775 are allowed in the current allocation year 2021, no more than 1,582 are allowed in year 2022, no more than 1,345 are allowed in year 2023, and no more than 1,000 are allowed in year 2024 and beyond. Per Section 16.1110(o) no more than 35% of the total Growth and Revitalization Allocations available in any year may be granted to projects for a particular Planning Area. This 35% maximum allowed value is shown in each of the 4 Planning Areas. However, this maximum amount may not be available in some Planning Areas as other Planning Areas begin to reach their maximum given the overall limit. The total Adopted and Allowable Allocations shown at the bottom of this chart is therefore overstated.
