

Domestic Migration Flow (2016)

This report utilizes the latest release from the U.S. Census Bureau estimating county to county migration in the United States, excluding Puerto Rico and U.S. territories and those stationed abroad. This data is developed using the five-year American Community Survey. While other statistics are available in five-year format for 2017, county to county migration has not been updated since the 2015 release. This data shows the number of people who moved to and from Howard County by state and county. States and counties that do not display had an estimated 0 persons moving either to or from them as they relate to Howard County.

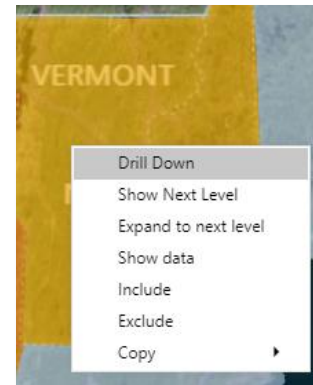
- Use the navigation buttons located at the bottom of the window to navigate between this introductory page and the report.

- Zoom in and out of the map using your mouse's scroll wheel or the + - buttons in the upper right portion of the map. Pan by clicking the left button and dragging the pointer.

- The report initially displays on the state level but to reveal the counties within a state simply right-click the state of interest and select the "Drill Down" option from the pop-up. This will zoom the map in to the state and reveal the individual counties within that contributed to migration flow in Howard County. To return to the state-view right-click within the map and select "Drill Up" from the pop-up.

- Hover your pointer over a state or county to reveal a detailed pop-up of additional information.
