Police charge three in home burglary series

Howard County police have charged three men in a series of home burglaries throughout December.

German Jossue Perez-Espinoza, 18, of 8264 Glen Court in Jessup; Malik Ka'onte Holloman, 19, of 8344 Stickley Court in Jessup; and Aleister Terrill, 19, 10521 Vista Road in Columbia have been charged with burglary, theft, destruction of property and handgun violations.

Police began investigating a series of burglaries earlier this month and determined that there could be as many as ten cases that might be linked throughout the county. Through investigation, detectives identified Holloman and Perez-Espinoza as possible suspects.

On Dec. 21, officers in the Glenelg area observed three suspicious subjects leaving a residence with backpacks on Sharp Road. Investigation revealed the home had been burglarized. The men were stopped and officers observed property taken in the burglary, including two guns. The suspects were identified as Holloman, Perez-Espinoza and Terrill, and taken into custody.

Police served search warrants at the homes of all three men and found property believed to be stolen in additional home burglaries. Detectives are sorting through the evidence and expect to file additional charges.

They each are being held at the Howard County Detention Center on \$500,000 bond.
