Police investigating pedestrian collision involving a child in Elkridge

Howard County police are investigating an incident in which a child was struck by a vehicle and seriously injured in Elkridge.

At approximately 4:26 p.m., a 2013 Jeep Wrangler was traveling eastbound in the 6100 block of Hunt Club Road when it struck a 9-year-old boy on a bicycle. Preliminarily, police believe the child entered the travel portion of the roadway from a residential driveway when he was struck.

The child was transported to Johns Hopkins Hospital with injuries that may be life-threatening. The driver of the vehicle, a 46-year-old woman from Elkridge, remained on the scene and was uninjured.

The investigation is ongoing.
