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Warrant issued for bank robbery suspect Nathan Fischer

Howard County police have obtained an arrest warrant for a man suspected of robbing a bank late last month and are asking for the public's help in locating him. Nathan Eric Fischer, 30, of no fixed address, is accused of robbing the PNC Bank in the 3900 block of Ten Oaks Road in Glenelg on Jan. 20.

At approximately 10:08 a.m., a man, later identified as Fischer, entered the bank, approached a teller and demanded money. The teller complied and provided an undisclosed amount of cash. The suspect fled the bank. No one was injured.

Through investigation, police identified Fischer as the suspect. He is described as a white male, approximately five feet eight inches tall and 200 pounds. At the time of the robbery, he had red facial hair and was wearing a grey hoodie, purple t-shirt, dark-colored jeans and a camouflage hat. Investigators believe he may be driving a tan 2003 Chevrolet Silverado with Maryland tag 5CR5112.

The department is offering a reward of up to \$1,500 for information in this case. Anyone with information should contact police at 410-313-STOP or HCPDcrimetips@howardcountymd.gov.

At this time, detectives have not linked Fischer to any other cases. The investigation is ongoing.

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
