**ARREST UPDATE: PREVIOUSLY REPORTED ROBBERY COMMERCIAL**

**BEAT B5 SHELL GAS STATION, 6200 WASHINGTON BLVD, 7/28 1935:** A suspect entered the store on July 28, approached the counter, threatened an employee with a handgun and demanded money. The employee complied and the suspect fled. No one was injured. 15-73285

**ARRESTED:** Kevin Lewis Green Jr., 27, of Baltimore, charged with armed robbery, robbery, first- and second-degree assault, theft and several weapons violations.

**ADDITIONAL SIGNIFICANT INCIDENT:**

**BEAT E2: 9400 WASHINGTON BLVD, 8/5 1625:** Police officers responded to a report of a collision involving an adult male riding a bike. Preliminary investigation indicates he was traveling southbound on Washington Boulevard and crossed the roadway, failing to yield to oncoming traffic. He was struck by a Chevy van and transported to the University of Maryland Shock Trauma Center where he was listed in stable condition. No charges have been filed. The collision remains under investigation.
