COMMERCIAL ROBBERY

BEAT A4 CROWN GAS, 8500 BALTIMORE NATIONAL PK, 8/14 1326: A suspect entered the business, approached the clerk, displayed a gun, and demanded money. The clerk complied and the suspect fled.

No one was injured. Investigation is continuing. 15-79266

SUSPECT(S): Black male, 5 feet 10 inches tall, medium build, dark complexion, bald, long-sleeve white shirt, light gray hoodie, gloves, shorts, and white sneakers.

SUSPECTS: #1 – Hispanic male, 5 five feet 7 inches to 5 feet nine 9 inches tall, hat, blue shirt, shorts.

#2 – Hispanic male. No further description.

BEAT C3 9700 BROKEN LAND PKWY, 8/16 1520: The female victim was in a parking lot when she was approached by a male suspect with a gun who demanded money. She complied and the suspect fled. A second suspect was observed nearby. No one was injured. Investigation is continuing. 15-80097

SUSPECTS: #1 – Black male, dark complexion, approximately 15-17 years old, 5 feet 9 inches to 5 feet 10 inches tall, approximately 160 pounds, thin and fit build, short cropped hair, red shirt, dark shorts.

#2 – Black male, approximately 16-18 years old, 5 feet 10 inches tall, approximately 170-180 pounds, white shirt, dark shorts.
