NON COMMERCIAL ROBBERY

BEAT C1 5800 ROBERT OLIVER PL, 8/18 2100 LATE REPORTED: An employee of the Lucky's China Restaurant was outside the business when he was approached by four juvenile male suspects who punched him and took his money. The suspects fled. No further suspect description. 15-81981
