**BURGLARY COMMERCIAL**

**ATTEMPTED MURDER**

**BEAT F1 1100 SHAFFERSVILLE ROAD, 4/23 2128:** An adult male victim reported that he got into a verbal altercation with a male relative who subsequently shot at him. No one was injured. Officers responded and upon further investigation, the suspect was arrested. 16-38807

**ARRESTED:** Michael Eugene Myers Sr., 62, of Shaffersville Road, Mt. Airy, charged with attempted second-degree murder, first- and second-degree assault, reckless endangerment and use of a firearm in commission of a felony.

**ASSAULT**

**BEAT B1 8800 COLUMBIA 100 PARKWAY (EXTENDED STAY) 4/23, 1045:** Officers responded to the hotel for a report of gun shots. Three people who knew one another were involved in an altercation. No one was shot, but a gun and drugs were located. One man, Michael Roy Terry, 33, of Clarinda Avenue, Baltimore, was taken to Shock Trauma for a laceration, released and arrested. Selina Ashley Miller, 33, of Bigley Avenue, Halethorpe, was arrested at the scene. Terry and Miller were charged with first- and second-degree assault, firearms violations, drug possession, and reckless endangerment. A third involved person was transported to Howard County General Hospital with minor injuries. Detectives are investigating to determine if additional charges will be filed.16-38608
