ROBBERY COMMERCIAL

BEAT E3 SHELL GAS, 9200 ALL SAINTS RD, 5/23 0227: Two male suspects with their faces partially covered, one armed with a gun, entered the business and demanded money from an employee. The employee complied. The suspects stole cigarettes, money and the employee's cell phone and fled. No one was injured. Investigation is continuing. 16-48798

SUSPECTS: Both suspects were described as black males, wearing masks, dark sweatshirts with the hoods up and jeans.
