Police identify suspect arrested following bank robbery

Howard County Police are identifying the suspect arrested in connection with the robbery of a Woodbine bank on Friday afternoon.

Paul M. Scovronski, Jr., 27, of Wintersville, OH, has been charged with robbery, armed robbery, theft, and first-degree assault after police were called to PNC Bank in the 15900 block of Old Frederick Road in Woodbine at approximately 12:36 p.m. on March 11 for a robbery in progress.

A male suspect with his face partially covered entered the bank, displayed a handgun and demanded money. An employee complied and the suspect fled. No one was injured.

Officers provided a vehicle description to nearby jurisdictions and Maryland State Police located the vehicle and arrested the driver and sole-occupant, Scovronski on Route 340 near the MD/VA line.

Scovronski is being held at the Howard County Detention Center on \$500,000 bond.

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
