### **Police identify victim in Elkridge homicide**

Howard County Police have confirmed the identity of a woman found dead inside her residence during a fire in the Capitol Mobile Park in Elkridge this morning. Stacey Lynn Fuller, 39, of the 6600 block of Washington Blvd., was pronounced dead by paramedics at the scene. It appeared she had suffered a traumatic injury unrelated to the fire, possibly a gunshot wound.

Police are investigating the incident as a homicide. Detectives do not have suspect information to release at this time.

At approximately 10:35 a.m., dispatch received multiple calls for a fire at the Capitol Mobile Park.

The Howard County Department of Fire and Rescue Services arrived and discovered Fuller deceased inside the residence. No one else was in the home at the time. The fire was extinguished shortly after fire fighters' arrival and the cause is undetermined.
