### **Pedestrian struck and killed in Elkridge**

*Two vehicles involved, one fled scene*

Howard County police are investigating a fatal collision involving a pedestrian who was struck this morning while walking along Route 1 in Elkridge. Investigators are seeking information about an unknown vehicle that left the scene.

At 4:40 a.m., a 2002 Toyota SUV was traveling northbound on Route 1, also known as Washington Blvd., just prior to Bonnie View Lane, when it struck a woman walking in the travel portion of the roadway.

The driver of the Toyota immediately stopped on the side of the road. While the Toyota was stopped, a second vehicle traveling northbound on Washington Blvd. struck the victim while she was lying in the roadway. The second vehicle did not remain at the scene.

The victim will be publicly identified after next-of-kin has been notified of her death.

The driver of the Toyota was identified as Anthony Keith Corbin, 53, of Elkridge. Corbin was not injured and is cooperating with the police investigation. He described the second vehicle as a dark-colored SUV.

Police are asking for any information in an attempt to identify the dark-colored SUV. Anyone with information is urged to call 410-313-4752.

Northbound Washington Blvd. was closed for approximately five hours for the investigation. The road closure was handled by members of the State Highway Administration's Coordinated Highways Action Response Team (CHART).
