Police investigate three vehicle collision in Columbia

Urge witnesses to contact investigators

Howard County Police are investigating a three vehicle collision that occurred on March 13 at approximately 8:18 p.m. on Broken Land Parkway near Hickory Ridge Road in Columbia.

A 2005 Honda Accord was traveling westbound when it left the roadway, travelled over the median and struck a 2002 Saturn SL2 that was traveling eastbound on Broken Land Parkway. The Honda then struck a 2004 Mitsubishi Lancer. The driver of the Honda was ejected from the vehicle.

The driver and single occupant of the Honda has been identified as Elijah Walter Jackson, 29, of Columbia. Jackson was transported to the University of Maryland Shock Trauma Center in stable condition.

The driver of the Saturn has been identified as Jonathan Colin Winkert, 20, of Highland. Winkert was transported to the University of Maryland Shock Trauma Center in stable condition. A passenger in the Saturn has been identified as Jocelyn Michelle Butrum, 21, of Highland. Butrum was transported to Howard County General Hospital in stable condition.

The driver of the Mitsubishi has been identified as Ganzorig Choijil, 56, of Ellicott City. Choijil was transported to the Howard County General Hospital in stable condition.

Eastbound Broken Land Parkway between Hickory Ridge Road and Rt. 29 was closed to traffic until 10:00 p.m. for the investigation. The collision is being investigated by HCPD's Traffic Enforcement Section.
