Police investigate two-vehicle collision in Clarksville

The Howard County Police Department is investigating a two-vehicle collision that occurred at approximately 6:36 p.m. on Route 32 near Route 108 in Clarksville.

Preliminary investigation revealed that a Honda Civic was on right shoulder of Route 32 eastbound and attempted to make a U-turn when it was struck by a Ford F-250 pick-up truck that was also traveling eastbound.

The driver of the Honda, a 27-year-old female, and passenger, a 24-year-old female, were transported to the University of Maryland Shock Trauma Center.

The driver of the Ford, a 34-year-old male, was not injured. A passenger in the Ford, a 35-year-old male, was transported to Howard County General Hospital.

Route 32 remains closed in both directions between Linden Church Road and Route 108 as police continue to investigate.
